

## **Cyberaddicts in elderly: data and perspectives.**

Problematic Internet use in elderly has received little interest within the medical literature until now. This points to the need of specific research to better apprehend the current and potential future public health issues specific to this part of the population. Even if the currently elderly may only moderately be concerned by internet related health problems, current data on young adults point to a future need to seriously consider the development of prevention policies and health care programs specifically tailored to the aging population.
